Dear Preschool Parents,

Please review the following discipline policy which is also included in your parent handbook. We were asked by DCFS to separate this from the handbook, and have you read it again and sign the bottom portion and return it to us so that we can keep it in your child's folder indicating that you are aware of our discipline procedures.

## Discipline

The word "discipline" means "to teach", it does not mean "to punish". The first goal in discipline is to protect your child from danger. Another very important goal is to teach your child an understanding of right from wrong, and to teach respect for the rights of others. Our goal is to teach each child to be responsible for his/her own behavior. The teachers guide the children to settle disagreements among themselves. The most effective actions are ignoring the misbehavior, redirecting the child to appropriate behavior, or giving your child "renewal time". When it becomes necessary for a teacher to intervene, the child(ren) will be corrected in a kind way, expressing the misbehavior as a clear and concrete rule. If a child persists with inappropriate behavior, the parent will be informed verbally or in writing. A teacher may request a conference if the child shows repeated lack of self-control. We will offer behavior support and transition plans involving the local school district. Situations that remain unresolved or pose a danger to the student or others may result in dismissal.
